

- Two previous redevelopment attempts






# Existing Conditions Overview


The Armory has been vacant for nearly 30 years and is in need of significant and costly repairs and restoration.



#### **Scale Comparisons**




- 835,000 square feet of programmable space

- **181,000** square feet of clear area in the Drill Hall















